Heidi. I have a couple of corrections to the Land Use Plan regarding fisheries and Fisheries Mgmt on GSL

I don't know if this is in time to make the edit before the draft print, but surely can be included for further discussion.

- CR#13: Regulatory Authorities will only permit commercial fishing on lakes with the support of the affected First Nation. (I think it would be more accurate if the next sentence read) *"This statement does not apply to Great Slave Lake which will continue to be co-managed by DFO and the Great Slave Lake Advisory Committee"* This reference occurs on page 23 and again on page 62.
- And in the next paragraph the final sentence of CR#13 would be more accurate if it read *"Because there are ongoing fisheries on Great Slave Lake and because there are transboundary issues regarding fish stocks and fisheries, the lake will be co-managed by DFO and the Great Slave Lake Advisory Committee, which has representative members from all the affected First Nations, as well as other affected organizations and fishery resource users."*

My suggested changes are in italics. Please give me a call on whether or not you are in agreement or to work on more precise wording if necessary.
