Dear Mrs. Heidi Wiebe

I have been working on a proposal for tourism in my traditional area (Sibbeston Lake and Little Doctor Lake). I'm having trouble getting a Lodge establish, because it is in Withdrawn Lands.

My family is one of the only families that still make a living off of our traditional area and we have decided to do tourism to create employment for ourselves. We are having trouble with this because when my family made a decision to withdraw lands, we were not told that it was going to be withdrawn from us.

I have written a letter to the Minister of RWED, he suggests that I work with the Liidlii Kue First Nations and Landuse planning Committee on this, which is why I'm calling on you. I have also spoke with Alison de Pelham from Dehcho First Nations and she said there was lands to be open through the Landuse Planning where this might be able to work for me.
